What is a counter objection?

A counter objection is a response to an objection received to the Draft Bermuda Plan 2008.

Who can submit a counter objection?

Anyone who has an interest in an objection can submit a counter objection.

When can I submit a counter objection?

You can submit a counter objection at any time before the Tribunal hearing. All Tribunal hearing dates, details and agendas will be available a minimum of 7 days before the hearing. You must make the Tribunal aware of your counter objection at least one business day before the hearing date.

How do I find out about the objections?

There is a Register of Objections and accompanying maps available to inspect at the Department of Planning and on the website www.planning.gov.bm. Objection files can be inspected by the public at the Department of Planning during regular business hours.

Do I have to use this form to counter object?

It is recommended that you use this form but you can submit a letter with the same information as on the form.

Where do I submit the counter objection?

Please submit your counter objection to: The Draft Bermuda Plan 2008 Tribunal c/o Department of Planning, Government Administration Building, 30 Parliament Street, Hamilton Bermuda HM 12

What happens to my counter objection?

A copy of your counter objection will be provided to the objector and to the Tribunal for information.

Am I required to attend the Tribunal hearing?

All Tribunal hearings are open to the public. A person who submitted a counter objection may only speak at the hearing if invited to do so by the Tribunal. Your attendance is not required but it is recommended that you attend.

What happens after the Tribunal hearing?

No decision is made at the Tribunal hearing itself. The Tribunal will make recommendations to the Minister of the Environment and Sports about all objections to the Draft Bermuda Plan 2008.
